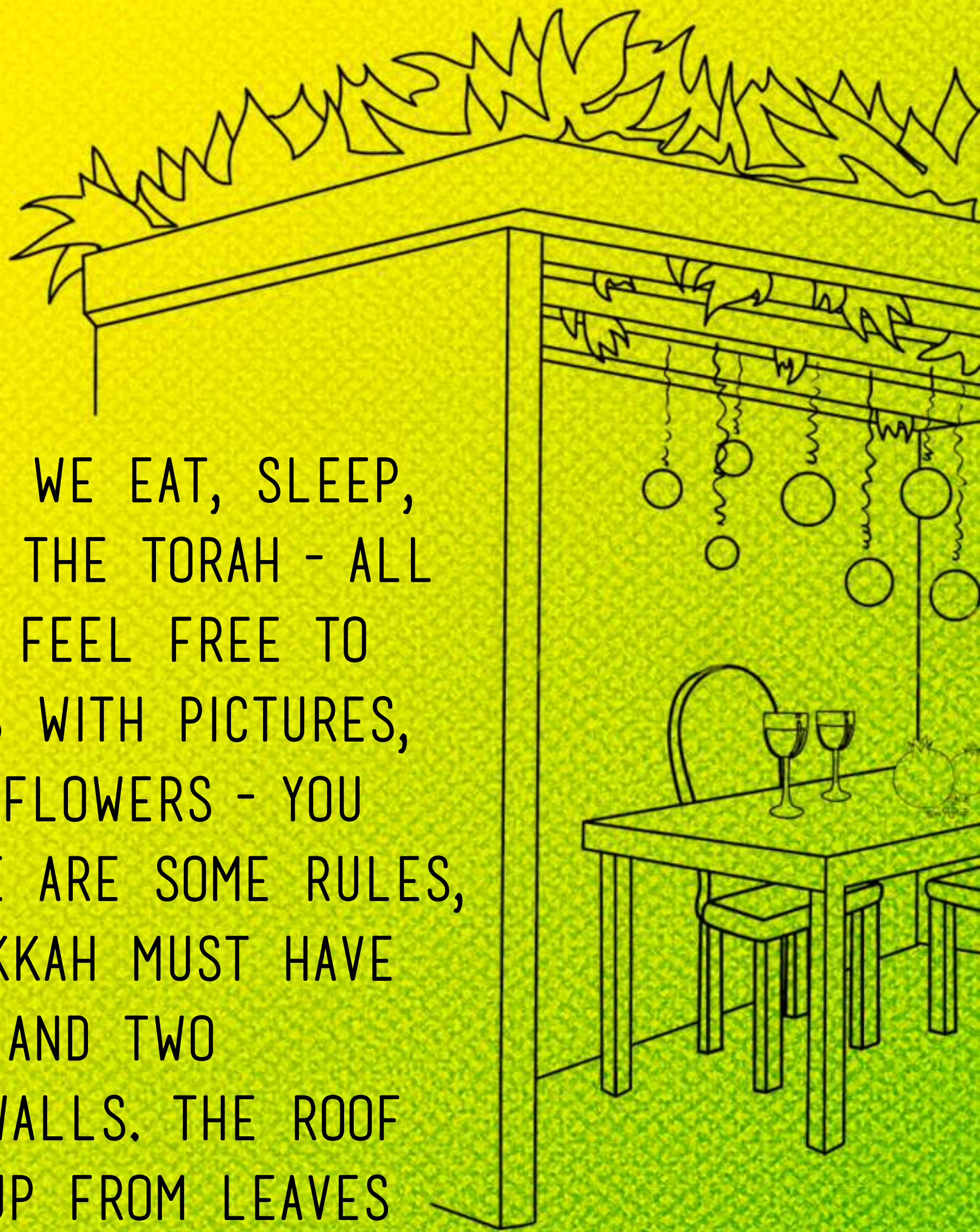

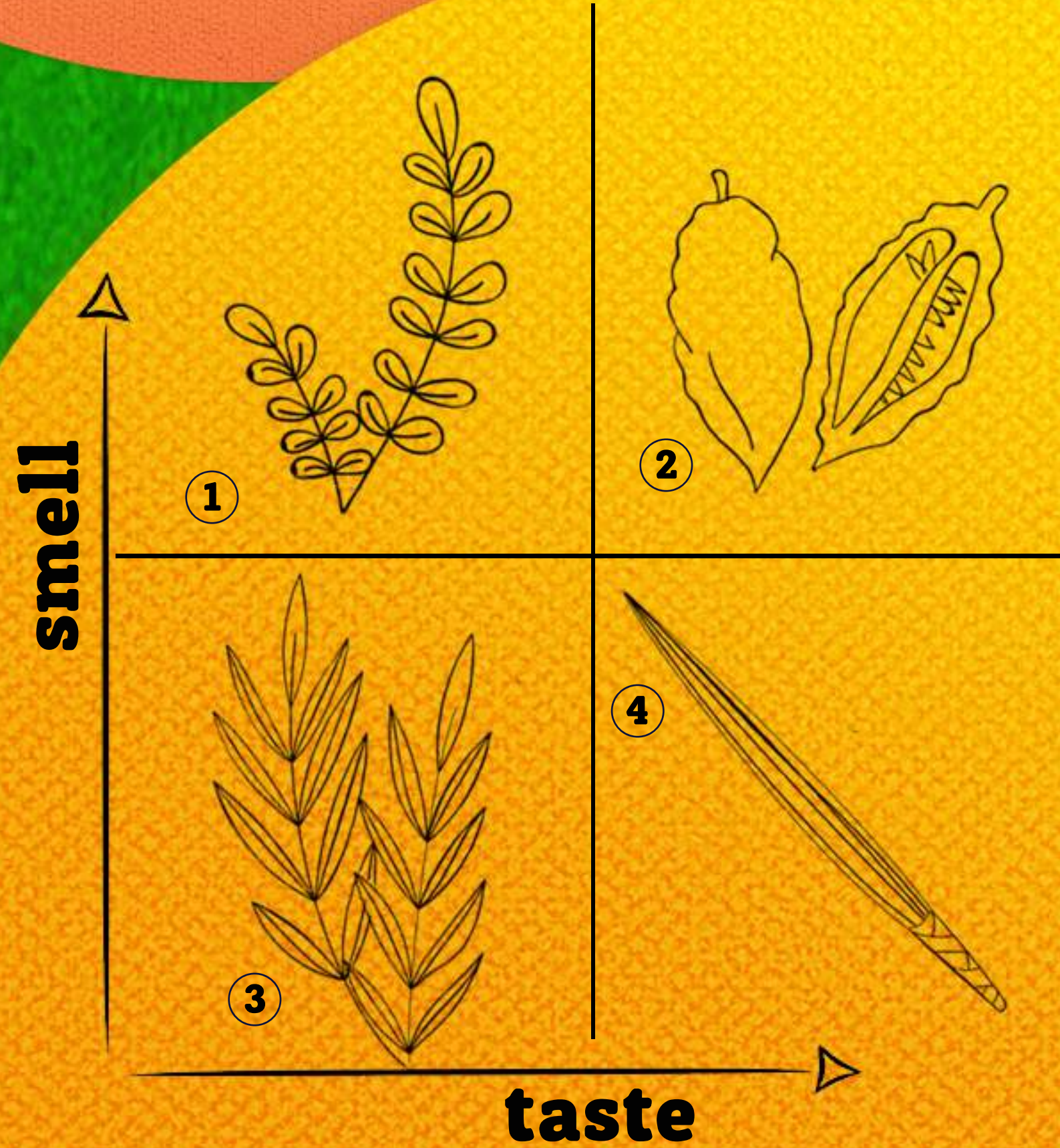

DURING SUKKOT WE EAT, SLEEP,
AND READ FROM THE TORAH - ALL
IN THE SUKKAH! FEEL FREE TO
DECORATE YOURS WITH PICTURES,
LIGHTS, FOODS, FLOWERS - YOU
NAME IT! THERE ARE SOME RULES,
THOUGH. A SUKKAH MUST HAVE
ONE PARTIAL AND TWO
COMPLETE WALLS. THE ROOF
IS MADE UP FROM LEAVES
AND BRANCHES. THIS HELPS BLOCK OUT THE
SUNLIGHT DURING THE DAY, BUT STILL
LETS US VIEW THE STARS AT NIGHT!

PLANTS, OR
SPECIES, ARE:

- ① HADASS**
BOUGHS WITH LEAVES
FROM A MYRTLE TREE
- ② ETROG**
THE FRUIT FROM A
CITRON TREE
- ③ ARAVAH**
BRANCHES WITH LEAVES
FROM A WILLOW TREE
- ④ LULAV**
A RIPE, GREEN,
CLOSED FROND
FROM A DATE
PALM TREE

THE FOUR SPECIES

WAIVING THE LULAV

- FACE EAST **E**
- SHAKE FORWARD **↓**
THREE TIMES
- SHAKE RIGHT **→**
THREE TIMES
- SHAKE LEFT **←**
THREE TIMES
- SHAKE UP **↑**
THREE TIMES
- SHAKE DOWN **↓**
THREE TIMES
